"Metro Transit is excited to announce K-12 Rides Free, a pilot program to offer free access to bus, MOBY, and ORBT services for kindergarten through 12th-grade students in the Omaha region during Metro's regular service hours. The program will run from May 10, 2021 through June 1, 2022. All K-12 students in the Omaha metro and surrounding area are eligible.

High school students must show a valid school-issued ID when boarding. For those who do not have a school-issued ID, Metro will provide one. Identification will not be required for elementary and middle school students. Details can be found at [ometro.com/k-12](https://ometro.com/k-12).
